The Barcelona School of Economics (BSE) organizes the Tenth BSE Summer Forum. The Summer Forum is a series of independent workshops that cover the main fields of Economics. The Summer Forum 2023 will take place from June 6 to June 20, 2023. The venue will be UPF Balmes Building (Balmes 132) in central Barcelona.

We would like to invite you to submit a paper to the workshop:

FINANCIAL SHOCKS, CHANNELS, AND MACRO OUTCOMES

The workshop will run for 1.5 days and will take place on 15-16 June 2023, in Barcelona.

The goal of this workshop is to discuss recent developments in research on the real effects of financial shocks and frictions. We are particularly interested in applied theoretical and empirical work on the interplay between finance, micro- and macro-shocks, and their short-run and long-run effects. We encourage submissions addressing issues including (but not limited to):

- Financial frictions, bank lending, and the real effects of the misallocation of credit.
- Micro data (on finance and real outcomes) for macro questions.
- Financial frictions, and the short- and long-run effects of macroeconomic shocks and policy.
- Links between inflation, asset prices, and credit, and their macroeconomic implications.
- Finance and the transition to a sustainable economy.
- Credit booms, asset prices, and macro outcomes.
- Finance, innovation, productivity, and growth.
- Distribution of financial assets and macroeconomic amplification.

The deadline for submissions is **February 28, 2023**. To submit a paper, please use this link <https://app-summerforum.bse.eu/>. Submissions should include either a full paper or an extended abstract with the main results. Authors chosen to present papers will be notified approximately by the end of March. A preliminary program will be announced by the end of April.



Please note that the BSE Summer Forum is a series of independent workshops. When you submit your paper, you will be able to see the topics and dates of other workshops that will take place within the Summer Forum. The same paper **cannot be submitted to more than one workshop**, but you are welcome to submit a different paper to a different workshop.

There is no registration fee, and meals during the workshop will be provided for participants. In principle, it is expected that the speakers will be covering travel and accommodation expenses but, if needed, some workshop funding support can be requested.
