The Barcelona School of Economics (BSE) organises the Tenth BSE Summer Forum (SF). The Summer Forum is a series of independent workshops that cover the main fields of Economics. This edition takes place from 6th to 20th June 2023 at the UPF Balmes Building (Balmes 132) in central Barcelona. #### PUBLIC ECONOMICS

Applications to act as discussant are equally encouraged.

The workshop takes place on 14th-15th June 2023. It covers the core topics of Public Economics, ranging from the collection of resources to the public provision of goods and services. It also covers aspects at the frontier between Public Economics and Political Economy, such as voting, government formation, federalism and the design of public institutions. We encourage submissions of both theoretical and empirical papers.

The deadline for submissions is **28th February 2023**. Please, submit your paper here: <https://app-summerforum.bse.eu/>. You should include either a full paper or an extended abstract. By the end of March, we will notify the authors of the selected papers. By the end of April, we will post the preliminary program. Please, specify in the 'comments' section of the application form if you are willing to act as a discussant.

Please note that you **cannot submit a paper to several workshops**, but you are welcome to submit different works to different workshops. While submitting your paper, you will see the list of topics and dates of the other Summer Forum workshops.

There is no registration fee. Lunch and coffee breaks are provided for participants, however, we **do not** provide accommodation or travel support for speakers.
