The 10th BSE Summer Forum, a series of independent workshops organized by the Barcelona School of Economics (BSE), will take place from June 6 to June 20, 2023. STRUCTURAL MICROECONOMETRICS

The workshop is set to take place 8-9 June 2023 with **Luigi Pistaferri (Stanford)** as keynote speaker.

The workshop is jointly organized by the BSE and MOVE. As in previous editions, the goal is to bring together leading researchers in the estimation of structural microeconometric models on different topics (labor, IO, development...). Submissions from well-established researchers as well as promising young scholars are welcome.

Full papers or extended abstracts with key results can be submitted at https://app-summerforum.bse.eu/ until **February 28, 2023**. Accepted presenters will be notified by the end of March and a preliminary program announced by the end of April.

Note that the same paper **cannot be submitted to more than one workshop** but you are welcome to submit a different paper to a different workshop.

There is no registration fee and meals will be provided. The workshop organization **will not be able** to provide accommodation or travel support for speakers. There might be some limited funding for junior researchers that otherwise cannot fund their attendance. Please contact the workshop organizers if funding is an issue for you. The workshop is funded by the European Research Council (ERC), through Starting Grant 804989.
